## **Nomination Guidelines**

Do you know someone who is deserving of an Excellence Counts award? If so, please complete a nomination form. Below is a list of tips that the reviewing committee has identified to help you with your submission.

- Excellence Counts nomination forms are available in the main offices of each building and can be downloaded from the District 215 webpage (<u>www.tfd215.org</u>).
- The reviewers may not know your nominee except through your nomination. The reviewers are relying on your words and specific examples to appreciate the strength of your nominee's contributions.
- Be sure to select an Area of Excellence (Innovation, Enthusiasm, Dedication, Citizenship) AND a Category (Classroom, Student Services, School Environment, Ancillary Programs).
- Provide a list of individuals nominated if nominating a group or members of an organization.
