District 215 board president Michael Bolz said, "I am excited that Superintendent Lance has been asked to be on the Region 9 Comprehensive Center Advisory Board because she will have the opportunity to represent the needs of our district and other districts in the region and influence the use of federal resources to the benefit of students."
