Thornton Fractional South High School is located in the southeastern corner of Cook County, approximately 25 miles south of Chicago's Loop.

Opened in 1958, Thornton Fractional South High School serves students from the Lansing and Lynwood communities.

# **Special Program Offerings**

**Homework Center** – One-hour sessions two days each week within any subject with a certified teacher.

**Individual Tutoring Sessions**- Teachers are available to assist students on various lessons or assignments before or after school.
