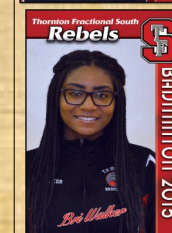
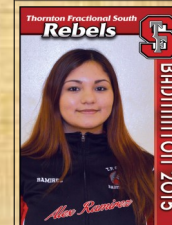

Jenna Pasko represented TF South at the State Tournament at Eastern Illinois University by finishing 1st at the TF South Sectional at #1 singles. Jessica was seeded 5th in the State and finished in 7th place.

Precious Powe and Kristi Fisher finished 1st at Doubles at our sectional and won 1 match at the State Tourney.

Fritzi Flores and Alex Ramirez won 1 match at the state tourney.

Bri Walker won 3 matches in singles at the State Tourney.

Finished a respectable 9th place out of 96 schools.

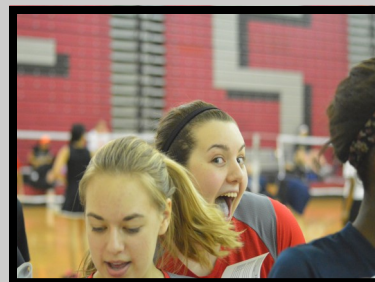

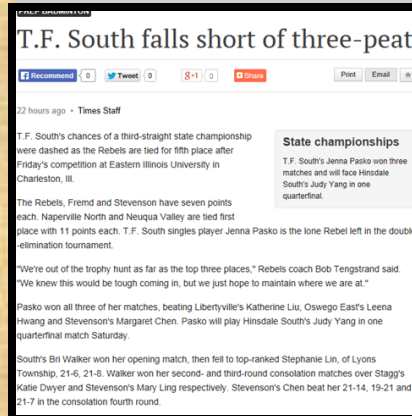
GOOD LUCK TO OUR SENIORS
