Jenna Pasko and Cassie Breshock finished 1st at Doubles and qualified for the State Tourney and were seeded 1st in the State and finished in 1st place.

Cameron Crosby and Paula Rodriguez were not seeded at the State tourney and finished in 9th place.

## Time & Commitment has made Badminton At TF South High School Unbelievable !

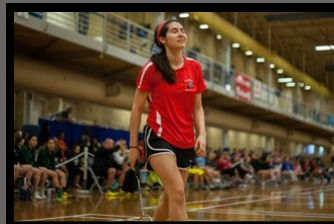
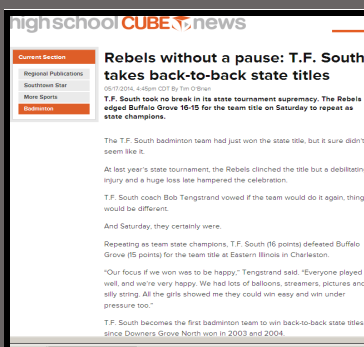


The TF South Girls Badminton program reached the ultimate goal in 2013 and again in 2014.

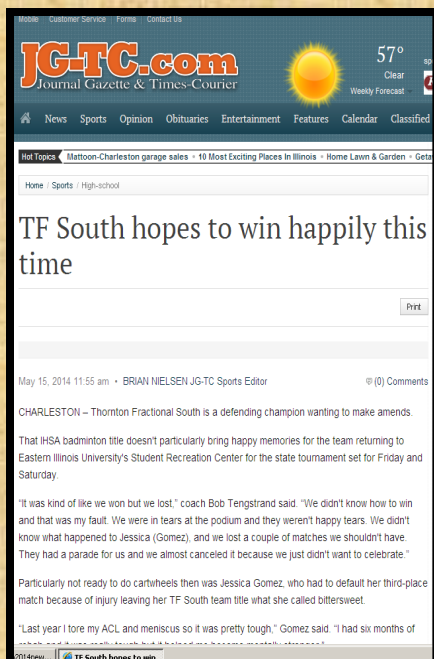

Thornton Fractional South High School and the Lansing Community deserved everything the Badminton Team accomplished.

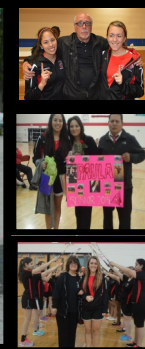

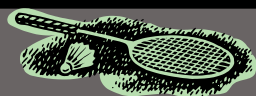
