What to bring to a

Financial Aid Application Completion Workshop

- Your 2022 federal tax returns, W-2's, and other records of money earned.
- Banking statements and records of investments (if applicable.)
- Records of untaxed income (if applicable).
- · List of colleges you would like to attend.

Additional information you will need if you are completing the FAFSA:

- · Social Security Number. Be sure it is correct!
- · Your Alien Registration Number, if you (student) are not a U.S. citizen.
- · An FSA ID. Note: Students and parents must each have a verified FSA ID to complete the FAFSA. Plan on setting up your FSA ID at studentaid.gov/FSA-ID at least one week prior to completing the FAFSA, since it will take some time for the verification process.
