ATTENDANCE POLICY

- Attendance is an important factor in student success
- You are expected to attend EVERY class. Attendance will be taken during every class period via Zoom.
- Valid reasons for an absence include:

 - Other reasons approved by administration

CALL OFF POLICY

TARDY POLICY



- Be sure to enter each online classroom ON TIME to ensure each teacher can take attendance and you are marked present. Failure to do so may result in you being marked tardy or absent.

This applies to any student that goes into a Zoom class, TFD215 students and non TFD215 students.



 - Texting
 - Calling
 - In person

HARASSMENT

No person, including a District employee or agent, or student, shall harass, intimidate or bully a student on the basis of actual or perceived race; color; nationality; sex; sexual orientation; gender identity; gender-related identity or expression; ancestry; age; religion; physical or mental disability; order of protection status; status of being homeless; actual or potential marital or parental status, including pregnancy; association with a person or group with one or more of the aforementioned actual or perceived characteristics; or, any other distinguishing characteristic.

EXAMPLES OF HARASSMENT

 Name-calling, using derogatory slurs, stalking, causing psychological harm, threatening or causing physical harm, threatened or actual destruction of property or wearing or possessing items depicting or implying hatred or prejudice of one of the characteristics stated above.

GANG ACTIVITY

- District 215 prohibits any form or participation in gang activity. No student on school property or at any school activity:
- 1. Shall wear, possess, use, distribute, display or sell any clothing, jewelry, emblem, badge, symbol, sign or other things which are evidence of membership or affiliation in any gang.
- 2. Shall commit any act or omission, or use any speech, either verbal or non-verbal (gestures, handshakes, etc.) showing membership or affiliation in a gang; or,
- 3. Shall use any speech or commit any act or omission in furtherance of the interests of any gang or gang activity, including, but not limited to:
 - A. soliciting others for membership in any gang
 - B. requesting any person to pay protection or otherwise intimidating or threatening any person
 - C. inciting other students to act with physical violence upon any other person.

DRUGS/WEAPONS

- If you are believed to be under the influence, your teacher reserves the right to remove you from the Zoom class and notify the Dean's Office.
- Make sure your space is clean and nothing that may be inappropriate, or looks like something inappropriate, is in view of the camera.
 - Failure to do so can result in you being removed from the Zoom class for the day and the Dean's Office being notified.
