New and returning students must submit the requirements below in order for registration to be complete.

Guardian Identification: A driver's license, State ID, or other photo identification verifying your identity may be provided

*If registrant is living with another household the homeowner must provide a driver's license or State ID, one item from Category 1, two items from Category II and the [Signed Affidavit](#) from Person Seeking to Enroll a Student While Living with a District Resident.

SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

PowerSchool– Documents will be uploaded in the “student address” portion of the registration process. If you have already completed the registration process, please log in to PowerSchool to submit the documents. Click on “**start registration**,” and then go to “**student address**.” **Upload the documents** and then click on the “**submit**” button at the bottom of the page.

If you are unable to upload your residency verification documents into PowerSchool, please contact the Pupil Personnel Services Department at (708) 585-1008.

Federal and state law protects the educational rights of homeless children. All residency will be verified through National Investigations Inc. A person who knowingly or willfully presents to the School District any false information regarding the residency of a student for the purpose of enabling that student to attend any school in that district without the payment of a non-residency tuition charge is guilty of a CLASS C MISDEMEANOR (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b(f)).
