Student Expectations

All College Step-up program students must abide by all school rules and regulations while being transported to and from SSC and while on campus. Being part of this program is an honor and privilege, one that can be taken away if a student violates any of the expectations listed below. The following list of misbehaviors is not exhaustive. The District reserves the right to discipline students (up to and including expulsion) for instances of misconduct not specifically described below.

- Observe the rights of other people.
- Report hazardous or dangerous situations to an adult.
- Treat others with respect regardless of their racial/ethnic origin, age, sex, religion, or disability.
- Maintain academic honesty.
- Maintain self-control and proper conduct at all times.
- Refrain from the use and/or possession of controlled substances, illegal drugs, or drug paraphernalia.
- Be truthful.
- Proper care of equipment and facilities.

Attendance & Grades

- Students are to learn and abide by each professor's individual attendance policy. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- Authorize SSC to release mid-term and final grade reports to District 215.

Financial Responsibility

Although the <u>TUITION</u> is waived (\$152 per credit hour), students and their families are responsible for the fees associated with the courses taken at South Suburban College. These fees include an instructional technology fee of \$10 per credit hour, and a student development fee of \$7.75 per credit hour; special course fees may apply.

The *first* three credit hour course fees equal \$53.25.

The *second* three credit hour course in the same semester fees will cost families <u>\$258.50</u>. (Note: these costs are estimates, actual cost may differ)

- Dropping a class after the drop deadline will result in the student being financially responsible for all tuition paid by District 215 and SSC.
- Dropping a class after the deadline and/or failing a class will have future financial aid implications.
- Official SSC transcripts must be requested by student if transferring college credit elsewhere. There is a fee of \$5.00 for each transcript.
