

SCHOOL DISTRICT 215 RESIDENCY VERIFICATION 2023-2024 New and returning students must submit the requirements below in order for registration to be complete. Guardian Identification: A driver's license, State ID, or other photo identification verifying your identity may be provided **CATEGORY 1 (One Item) CATEGORY 2 (Two Items)** Homeowner's warranty deed, trustee's deed or Home/apartment insurance bill or policy real estate tax bill, mortgage* Current Gas bill Signed renter's lease that is valid for the entire school year and includes the landlord's name Current Electric bill and phone number or a valid sublease listing Water bill your name as occupant and includes the landlord's name and phone number. Vehicle registration card Public Aid Card (if applicable) •

*If registrant is living with another household the homeowner must provide a driver's license or State ID, one item from Category 1, two items from Category II and the <u>Signed Affidavit</u> from Person Seeking to Enroll a Student While Living with a District Resident.

SUBMISSION OF DOCUMENTS

<u>PowerSchool</u> – Documents will be uploaded in the "student address" portion of the registration process. If you have already completed the registration process, please log in to PowerSchool to submit the documents. Click on "**start registration**," and then go to "**student address**." **Upload the documents** and then click on the "**submit**" button at the bottom of the page.

If you are unable to upload your residency verification documents into PowerSchool, please bring your documents to the school on (insert date/ times) to verify residency. If you have questions regarding verification or need assistance, please contact (insert email, phone number)
