<p>Transcripts are requested in Parchment</p>  <p>When creating your account be sure...</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• to use a personal email• DOB is accurate• “Last Year Attended” = Graduation Year	 <p>Send SAT scores to colleges</p>  <p>Send ACT Scores to colleges</p> <p>SAT/ACT score conversion table</p> <p>Many colleges are now test optional. This means that you are not required to send the test for the application process. A list of colleges that are test optional can be found at Fair Test. Please check each institution's policy before you apply.</p>

Scholarships	
<p>Most colleges automatically award merit-based and need-based scholarships to qualifying students as long as the FAFSA is completed and admission application is submitted by the early admission deadline (usually around November 1st but check each college's application for the exact date).</p> <p>Other scholarship resources: Naviance: "Colleges" > "Scholarship List" > "Local & Regional Scholarships" Use the filter and sort feature to easily find scholarships for which you are eligible.</p>
