Enrollments take place Monday – Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. You must have ALL the requirements below in order before enrollment can take place

RESIDENCY — All enrollments WILL be verified through National Investigations Inc.

A person who knowingly or willfully presents to the School District any false information regarding the residency of a student for the purpose of enabling that student to attend any school in that disitrict without the payment of a nonresidency tuition charge is guilty of a CLASS <u>C MISDEMEANOR (105 ILCS 5/10-20.12b(f).</u>

Student's Birth Certificate. (If father is NOT on birth certificate, he CANNOT enroll).

Proof of custody will be required if other than parent enrolling the student.
