# **Student Activities and Athletics**





# **Grading System**

A student at TF South is graded on a scale of A, B, C, D, and F. All courses are factored in to a student's Grade-Point-Average except those courses in which a student is given a Pass or Fail. TF South is only authorized to verify information which is a part of a student's permanent record.
